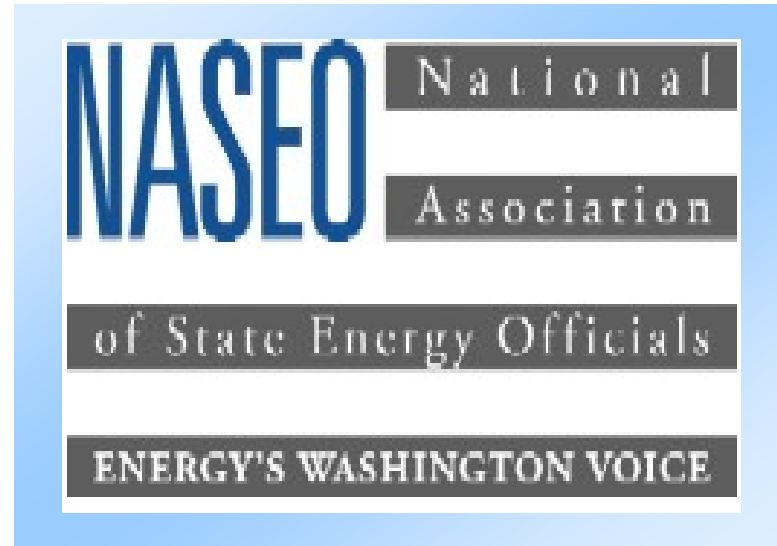
Role of State and Territory Energy Offices



- Formed in response to the energy crisis of the early 1970s
- Energy efficiency and renewable energy programs and projects
- Spur economic development and minimize the environmental impacts of growth
- Advise governors and legislators on energy issues
- Enhance energy security and improve state energy emergency mitigation and response capabilities

National Association of State Energy Officials

- Created by the National Governors Association
- “Energy’s Washington Voice”
- Guides understanding of energy's pivotal role in the economy and environment
- Informs officials of energy priorities and concerns of the states and territories
- Involvement in a range of energy issues

- Educates state and local leaders on the state governments' role in preparing for and responding to energy supply disruptions, shortages, and emergencies

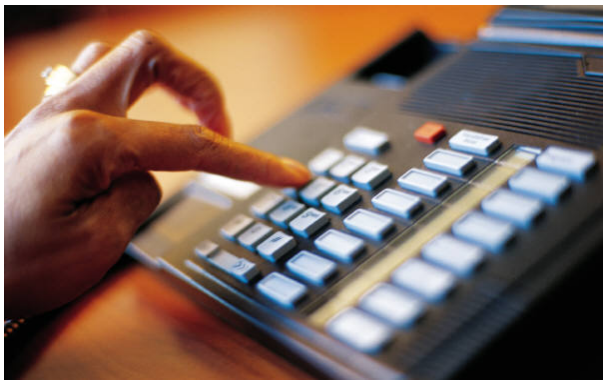

- Point of contact for DOE and industry in event of emergency



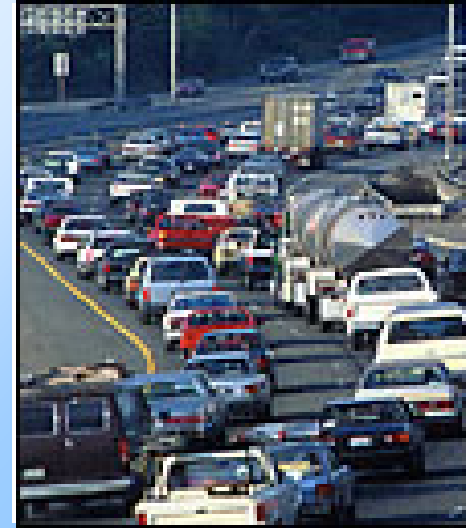
