Question #1:

If our state received a special energy assurance grant from DOE through NASEO in 2005 and closed it out in June 2006 are we eligible to apply for funding this year?

Response:

Yes, because the funds were received in 2005 your state is eligible to apply for funds under this latest solicitation.

Question #2:

Can funding under this grant be used for creating a solid tactical plan and drill on a petroleum shortage?

Response:

Yes. States can apply under "Area of Interest B" for funding to create a solid tactical plan and drill (or exercise) in a petroleum shortage scenario.

Question #3:

Does this mean that grant recipients will receive a portion of the total \$100,000 available? Or \$100,000 per grant recipient?

Response:

A total of \$100,000 is available to fund projects in up to eight (8) states. Selected proposals will be awarded up to a maximum of \$15,000 to pursue energy assurance planning and preparedness activities.
