Assignment:

Select **two** Best Practice areas in which your state's ESPC program has an opportunity to improve. Base your selection on the areas that you believe could provide the largest improvement in the efficiency and effectiveness of your state's ESPC program. These will likely be areas that you rated as "Weak" or "Needs Development" in the Program Analysis Matrix, but areas rated as "Strong" can also be considered. For each Best Practice that you select, please answer the following questions:

- 1) Identify which Best Practice you chose.
- 2) Why did you select this Best Practice as one that needs further development in your state's ESPC program? (Feel free to reference or expound upon your answer in the Program Analysis Matrix, if relevant.)
- 3) Are there barriers that have prevented this Best Practice from being a stronger component of your state's ESPC program? If so, what are they?
- 4) What are two or three specific changes that could be made to your state's ESPC program that relate to this Best Practice? What organization(s) or individual(s) are responsible for implementing these changes? Consider how to address any barriers identified in #3.
- 5) Please describe a "next step" or series of "next steps" that could be executed to implement each potential change to your state's ESPC program identified in #4. For what "next steps" do you or the State Energy Office have control over, and how can you move those forward? For "next steps" that are responsibilities of other agencies, how can the State Energy Office help catalyze action by those agencies?
