New Report Released on Resiliency of Electric Grid During Natural Disasters

The White House Council of Economic Advisors and the U.S. Department of Energy have recently released a report assessing the nation's electric grid, and how to best protect it from power outages during natural disasters. The report finds that grid resiliency is becoming more important as

climate change increases the severity and frequency of severe weather events.

President Signs Two Hydropower Bills into Law

President Obama signed the Hydropower Regulatory Efficiency Act, H.R.267, and the Hydropower and Rural Jobs Act, H.R.678, into law. H.R. 267, introduced by Representative Cathy McMorris Rodgers (R-WA), modifies the Federal Power Act and the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act to promote and facilitate the



development of hydroelectric power capacity. H.R. 678, introduced by Representative Scott Tipton (R-CO), amends the Reclamation Project Act of 1939 to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to contract for small conduit hydropower development at Reclamation facilities.



Congressman and DOE Official Explore Efforts to Enhance Energy Policy

On Wednesday, August 14, Congressman Paul Tonko (D-NY) and Dr. David Danielson, Assistant Secretary of the U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy, met with leaders of local businesses, educational institutions, non-profits, and others in upstate New York to

discuss opportunities through energy efficiency. They heard comments and suggestions on how the federal government, through Congress, can better work with the private sector to advance local efforts to improve energy policy. The meeting followed on a visit the previous day by the Congressman and DOE officials to General Electric's Global Research Center in Niskayuna, where discussion focused on keeping America's advanced

NYSERDA Announces Residential Energy Efficiency Bonds through Green JobsGreen New York

The New York State Energy Research and Development Authority has announced the sale of \$24.3 million in revenue bonds to finance residential energy efficiency improvement projects for consumers across the state. The bonds are guaranteed by



the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation and its State Revolving Fund program. The innovative method of securing the bonds could act as a model for other states.



Federally Owned Wind Facility to be Built in Texas

The National Nuclear Security
Administration's Pantex weapons
facility will soon be home to the
largest federally owned wind farm in
the country. The facility, located just
outside of Amarillo, Texas, will utilize
five 2.3 megawatt turbines over
1500 acres near the plant. Siemens
Government Technologies was
awarded the contract to build and

operate the wind farm.

NASEO and Other Organizations Submit Letter to Secretary Moniz on Appliance Efficiency Standards

On August 16, 2013, NASEO along with a broad coalition of energy efficiency and environmental organizations including the Alliance to Save Energy and the American Council for an Energy-Efficient Economy submitted a letter to Energy Secretary Ernest Moniz to commend the department for their efforts in the proposed rulemaking for new metal halide light fixture standards.

DOE's Advanced Manufacturing Office Publishes Early Results of Superior Energy Performance Program

A paper presented during the 2013 Study on Energy Efficiency in Energy, hosted by the American Council for an Energy-Efficient Economy, shows the nine companies certified in Superior Energy Performance (SEP) had an average energy improvement of 10% over the first 18 months. The average payback period for those companies was 1.7 years. The full results can be seen in the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory Report <u>Assessing the Costs</u> and Benefits of the Superior Energy Performance Program.

Ford to Offer CNG Version of the F-150 in 2014

The Ford Motor Company will be offering the F-150, its number one consumer and business vehicle, with an option for retrofitting to <u>compressed natural gas</u> (CNG), or liquefied petroleum gas (LPG). The option to convert the pick-up to CNG will cost an additional \$7,500 to \$10,000 dollars over the traditional gasoline fueled truck.

Colorado and RESNET Sign Agreement to Promote the Construction of High Energy Performance Homes

The Colorado Energy Office has entered into a <u>Memorandum of Understanding</u> with RESNET, agreeing to provide quarterly and annual reporting of the new homes market using HERS Index Scores to the real estate professional community. RESNET will provide quarterly and annual reviews of all new homes in Colorado that have received HERS Index Scores.
