Washington Clean Energy Fund Awards 10 Innovative Research, Development, and Demonstration Projects

The Washington State Department of Commerce has announced over \$8.2 million in grants from the state's Clean Energy Fund to 10 proposed projects that will support research, development and deployment of renewable energy technologies in Washington.



Colorado Passes Energy and Climate Bills Toward Governor's 100% Renewable Energy Roadmap

The State of Colorado ended May by enacting a flurry of clean energy bills aiming to decarbonize the state's electric and transportation sectors. On May 30th, Governor Polis signed seven climate and energy bills, addressing carbon caps for the electric grid, energy efficiency upgrades, renewable energy infrastructure, and new rules on the state's Public Utility Commission (PUC).

Utah Approves More than \$10 Million in Electric Vehicle Charging Equipment

In the past month, the State of Utah has approved three measures, which will



collectively invest more than \$10 million in EV charging infrastructure across the state.



Millington, Tennessee Attracts Biggest Solar Project in the State

After 3 years and \$100 million invested, the biggest solar farm in Tennessee is ready for use in Millington. The solar farm was once a horse ranch, which a local Navy base paid to maintain. Now, a partnership with the city of Millington; Tennessee Valley Authority; Memphis Light, Gas, and Water; the Navy, and Silicon Ranch is giving the space new life.



NASEO, Qualcomm, and the Texas A&M Agrilife Extension to Host Smart Technology Workshop in Texas

Hosted by the Texas A&M Agrilife Extension, NASEO, along with Qualcomm and other stakeholders, is continuing its commitment to long-term community resilience through the Smart Technology Roadmap for Texas.

NASEO, NEMA Host Western States Petroleum Shortage Response Workshop

On April 30-May 1, NASEO, in partnership with the National Emergency Management



Association, and with support DOE's Office of Cybersecurity, Energy Security, and Emergency Response, hosted a Petroleum Shortage Response Planning Workshop, for states in the Western region to support the development of multi-state coordination to address fuel shortage challenges during a catastrophic and wide-spread event.



States and NASEO Participate in DOE Clear Path VII Exercise

Last month, the U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Cybersecurity, Energy Security, and Emergency Response hosted the Clear Path VII functional exercise examining coordinated state, regional, and federal emergency potential response to an earthquake in the New Madrid Seismic Zone.
