What is RESTART?

RESTART@LTU is a Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) and Lawrence Technological University (LTU) program.

The program provides energy efficiency, sustainability, and waste reduction services at no cost to qualified Michigan businesses with less than 500 employees statewide and institutions of any size.





Core Services

RESTART works with businesses and not-for-profit energy users to speed the adoption of reasonable, practicable, and cost-effective onsite energy efficiency measures and deployment of clean energy technologies. We do audits that focus on:

- Fuel switching/Electrification
- Behind the meter generation and storage
- High energy efficiency lighting
- Heat recovery and reuse
- Intelligent meters/recommissioning building automation systems
- HVAC repairs/upgrades
- Retooling
- Chemical substitution



Subject Matter Expert Services

RESTART has a team of subject matter experts in electrification and mobility, grid resilience, energy efficiency, etc., that are available when needed and as needed.

RESTART@LTU Internship Program

The internship program works with Michigan institutions of higher learning and manufacturers to place students in an industrial setting to work on energy efficiency, waste reduction, or climate projects.

The objective is to accelerate the adoption of EE and RE technologies along with environmentally sound activities identified in the audits performed by RESTART and partners

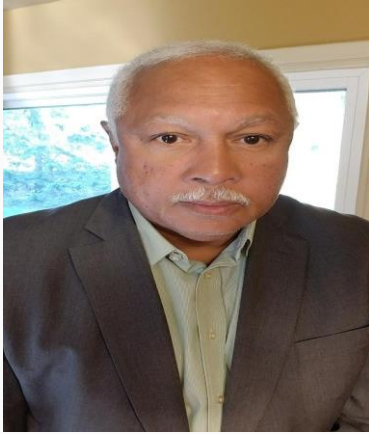


Financial Assistance
